

POPSICLE STICK SANTA!

Materials needed:

- Red texta
- Cotton ball
- Google eyes
- Red fuzzy wire
- White pom-pom



Instructions:

1. Grab a popsicle and colour the bottom end with red texta
2. Stick a cotton ball in the middle to make Santa's beard
3. Add google eyes just above it
4. Wrap a red fuzzy wire around the top of the popsicle to make santa's hat
5. Glue a white pom-pom to the top of the popsicle

DIY SNOW GLOBES

Materials Needed:

- Small, clear jars with lids
- Small plastic figurines (trees, snowmen, maybe even your favourite superhero character) or a pinecone
- Strong waterproof glue
- Glitter
- Water
- Glycerin (optional: it thickens the water for a slower “fall” effect)
- Twine or ribbon to decorate once the lid is secured




1. Glue the figurine to the inside of the lid and let it dry.
2. Fill the Jar: Add water, a few drops of glycerin, and a pinch of glitter to the jar.
3. Seal and Shake: Screw the lid back on, turn it upside down, and shake to see the “snow” fall.

DIY CHRISTMAS TREES

Materials Needed:

- Pine cones (larger, symmetrical ones work best)
- Green acrylic paint (or spray paint)
- Paintbrush
- Small beads, sequins, or tiny pom-poms
- Small star-shaped cut out or stickers (for the tree topper)
- Glue (hot glue gun or craft glue)
- Optional: glitter
- Bottle caps (for the tree "stand")
- Optional: twine or ribbon

Instructions:

1. Clean the pine cones. Rinse them well to remove any dirt and insects.
2. Paint the tips of the pine cone scales green to resemble a Christmas tree. Allow the paint to dry completely.
3. Add "Ornaments". Use a hot glue gun or craft glue to attach small beads, sequins, or tiny pom-poms to the tips of the pine cone scales. Arrange the decorations evenly across the pine cone.
4. Add a Tree Topper
Optional: Add Snow or Glitter
5. Create a Tree Stand. Glue the bottom of the pine cone into a small pot, bottle cap, or other stable base to keep it upright. You can also wrap the base with twine or ribbon for extra decoration.



PAPER PLATE ANGEL CRAFT

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Gold glitter
- White paper
- Gold sparkly pipe cleaner
- Tape or glue
- Sharpie
- Pink crayon



Instructions:

1. Cut the Plate
 - Cut a deep triangle shape out of the paper plate to form the angel's body.
2. Add Glitter
 - Apply glue along the edges of the plate, then sprinkle gold glitter over the glue to add sparkle. Shake off any excess glitter.
3. Create the Angel's Face
 - Cut out a small circle from white paper for the face. Use a Sharpie to draw eyes, a nose, and a mouth.
4. Add Rosy Cheeks
 - Lightly color in the cheeks with a pink crayon.
5. Attach the Halo
 - Bend the gold pipe cleaner into a circular halo shape, leaving a small tail for attaching. Tape the tail to the back of the face.
6. Assemble the Angel
 - Tape the face to the top of the plate (the narrow end of the triangle shape). Draw or attach small cutouts for hands if desired.
